



having been duly affirmed say on affirm the following:

1. I am the Claimant (*description of party*) in this case.
2. This Affidavit is to define documents I would like a copy of from the defense.
3. This affidavit has been rewritten and submitted in case of any legal loopholes that might be sprung on me at the hearing itself, and covers documents that have already been requested. Reminders about these outstanding documents were included in the statement of fact and law dated 30/3/2016 and also in email correspondence on 2/8/2016.
4. Documents requested on this same template on 25/1/2016
 - 4.1. On 27/11/2015 I have received from the defense a copy of the defenses building permit for their new limestone block retaining wall and a statement from the builder certifying that the new retaining wall complies with building regulations, however I am yet to receive
 - a) Any contour drawings associated with this permit.
 - b) Any building permit for the post and rail retaining wall that is built on the sewerage easement.
 - 4.2. The defense appear to consider that the tree that was tied to the retaining wall is a significant burden on that retaining wall. In order to put this into perspective I would like to know what model bobcat was used in the construction of this new retaining wall, and what the loaded weight of that bobcat would be carrying both a building block and a driver, accurate to the nearest 100kg.
 - a) If the defense have any photos of this tree I would like a copy so that I can submit them towards the independent report.
 - 4.3. A copy of the invoice for the default judgment costs, to put things into perspective.
 - 4.4. A copy of the legal bill to date for the defense, as requested in affidavit on 4/01/2016, to put into perspective the suffering and hardship that I am going through.
 - 4.5. A copy of the alternate quote to reinforce the retaining wall that the defense postponed one pre-trial conference for, and tried to postpone the second pre-trial conference to give time to obtain this quote.



4.6. A copy of any building permits or drawings containing contour lines on or near the Marshes property.

4.7. A list of building permits issued to 14 Trinity Rise, and the search invoice. The invoice is needed as these building permits pre-date the computer storage system records, and the records may not be found if a search is not done in the paper archives.

5. Email request for documents on 26 February, 2016.

- 5.1. Referring to "Listing conference memorandum" dated 17th February, 2016.
- Point 11. Unsigned letter from Agiuras to James Marsh dated 7th May, 2015.
- 5.2. The hand written letter and photos from Defendant to WA Building commission.

6. Documents requested for the first time.


6.1. Any building permits or other paperwork associated with the recently raised section of driveway into the Marshes property.
