
**25 – GENERAL ORDER**

BEFORE THE COURT ON 15 January 2016

**Upon the application of the Defendant lodged 3 November 2015 (as amended on 3 December 2015), IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. Time is extended for the Defendant to lodge and serve an amended application to set aside default judgment.
2. Default judgment entered on 17 September 2015 is to be set aside.
3. Leave is granted and time is extended for the Defendant to lodge and serve the Form 21 Statement of Defence to General Procedure Claim, Form 35 Affidavit Verifying Disclosure of Documents and Form 36 List of Documents to on or before 22 January 2016;
4. Time is extended for the parties to comply with Order 4 of the General Orders dated 30 July 2015 to on or before 19 February 2016.
5. The General Procedure Claim is adjourned to Wednesday 2 March 2016 at 9.30am for a listing conference at Bunbury Magistrates Court.
6. The Defendant pay the Claimant costs of the application to be assessed if not agreed.
7. Pursuant to Rule 109 (2) Magistrates Court (Civil Proceedings) Rules 2005, the Claimant is granted leave to make an oral application to join James Glynn Marsh as a second named Defendant in case BUN/GCLM/316/2015.
8. James Glynn Marsh be joined as a second named defendant in case BUN/316/15.
9. Service of an Amended Form 3 and Statement of Claim on the second named Defendant be dispensed with.
10. The second named Defendant be relieved of lodging a Notice of Intention to Defend and the service of the documents referred to in Order 3 apply to the second named Defendant.
